For nearly a century, Legal Aid Society has protected the rights of ordinary Kentuckians when a civil legal problem threatens their home, health, livelihood and family.

Over 177,000 individuals in Legal Aid Society's fifteen county service area live in poverty and qualify for our services. Seventy-one percent (71%) of low-income households experience at least one civil legal problem annually that significantly impacts their lives.

Legal Aid Society is here so that our neighbors don't have to face their legal problems alone. When someone needs an attorney, they have an attorney.

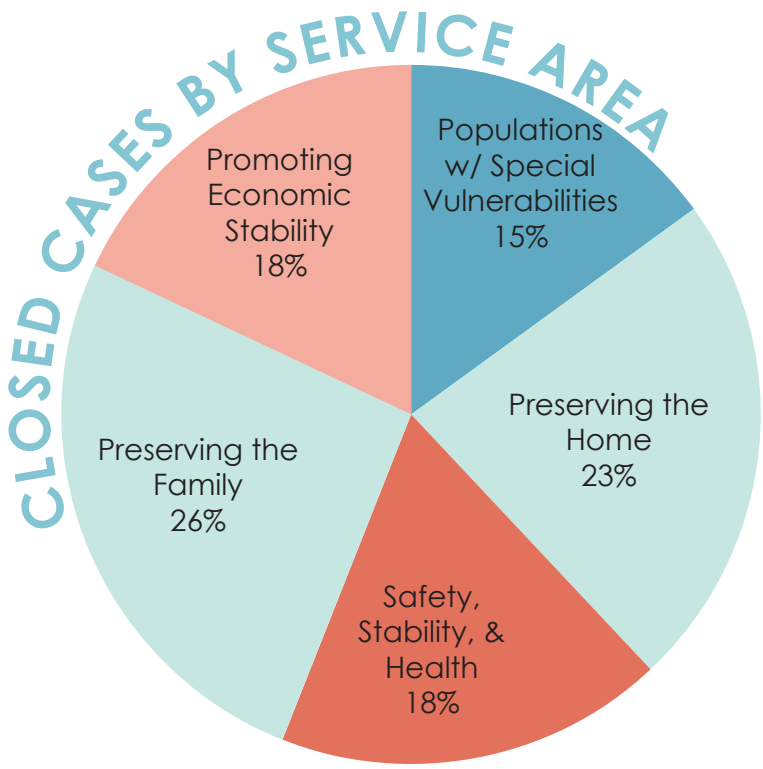

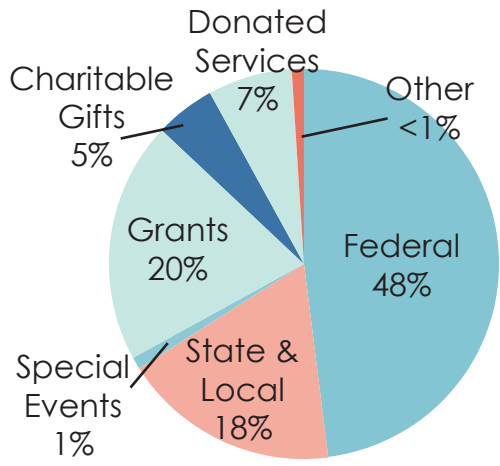

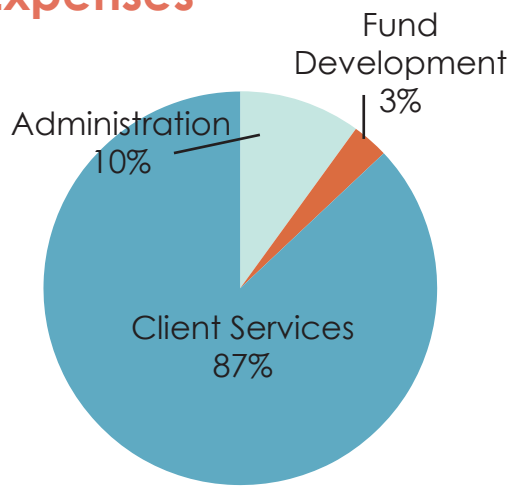

The eviction rate in Louisville is more than double the national average.

*Ms. Green, a 71-year-old retired school teacher, was facing an eviction and the prospect of becoming homeless. Ms. Green sought help from Legal Aid Society. Her Legal Aid attorney discovered that Ms. Green's landlord had actually refused to take her rent payments, rather than Ms. Green failing to pay as required. Ms. Green's attorney also discovered that Ms. Green was eligible for a first time home buyer program. Ms. Green's Legal Aid attorney negotiated a settlement that provided for the dismissal of the eviction and a date by which Ms. Green could move out with dignity. **Ms. Green is now a homeowner for the first time in her life.***

In Jefferson County alone, 15 individuals are evicted every day. Across the country, communities and families are struggling to find and retain affordable housing. The impact of eviction on families with children is devastating and negatively impacts the health, education, and emotional stability of families.

In 2017, Legal Aid helped over 600 households facing eviction. A study conducted by the Boston Bar Association found that nearly twice as many renters were able to avoid eviction with an attorney than without.

Legal Aid is for second chance see

A criminal record can feel like living a life-sentence long after your debt to society is paid.

That's how Chris felt when he came to Legal Aid in January 2017 seeking help expunging his record. In the late 1990's, Chris had written several cold checks out of desperation and had spent the vast majority of the last two decades unable to find quality employment due to his criminal history. Having served jail time and paid restitution, Chris still had few options. He really wanted and needed to work and earn a living. With help from Legal Aid Society, Chris was able to completely expunge his record and is now proudly employed, economically stable, and independent.

In 2017, Legal Aid Society's Economic Stability Unit helped 346 individuals achieve a fresh start and a second chance at a more prosperous and independent future.

Individuals with criminal records face tough barriers to obtaining a job or finding higher paying jobs. In fact, the stigma of a criminal record is enough to discourage more than half of employers from hiring someone.

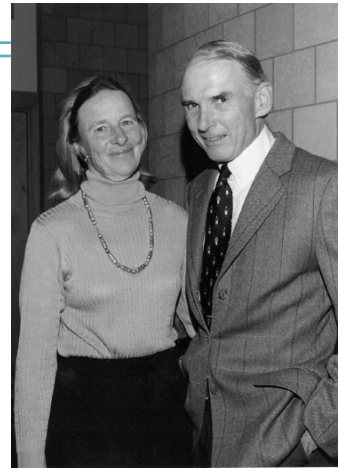
